APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

The Founder's Grant fund has been created, in recognition of our founding president, Dorothy Chantler, and the founding members of the Spirit of 67. The fund has been established to address time sensitive and important opportunities outside of our normal grant cycle. Anyone may apply for a grant from this fund, but the requests must be under \$1,000 and must be time sensitive. Each of the five District 67 schools will have access to a total of \$2,000 per building. All other grant requests should be submitted through the regular process / cycle. Each request will be evaluated by the building principal and the Grants Committee to ensure that they meet the goals of our Spirit of 67 Foundation mission.

- 1. Briefly describe the details of the grant request.**
- 2. Describe the benefits of the grant request and why it is needed right away.**
- 3. Who is responsible for implementing the grant request?**
- 4. List all costs for the grant request including material/product, shipping, installation, training, and ongoing maintenance.**

Please note:

- Individual grant requests may not exceed \$1,000, with a limit of \$2,000 per building.
- The Grants Committee will review grants at the end of each month. Applicants will be notified upon completion.
- This fund is intended for time sensitive ideas. All other grant proposals should follow the standard process and complete an application by January 25th, 2018.
- According to the Spirit of 67 Foundation Bylaws, the Spirit cannot fund the following types of requests:
 - Capital projects (i.e. "bricks and mortar")
 - Replacements
 - Consumables (food, craft supplies, etc.)
 - Field Trips
 - Staff stipends and salaries
 - Ongoing, multi-year projects
 - Non-curricular projects
